



## TOUR TO BRIHUEGA

### What do we visit?

Brihuega is a village of the Alcarria in Guadalajara. Last years has been positioned as one of the most important destinations in Spain thanks to the fields of lavender, whose flowers are full of color and smell in summer during July and part of August.

But this little village has much more to visit than only in one month and half per year, it has a great history. It was ruled by the bishops of Toledo, in my tour you will discover the Romanesque church Saint Mary of the Rock, the old caves from the Muslim period, the ancient building of the Royal Cloth Factory and their gardens or Museum of Professor Max of Miniatures.

In this guided tour to Brihuega you will feel the water in each fountain as for instance the 12 pipes water fountain "La Blanquina". And of course you can not finish without your honey jar and visit a lavender distillery too.



You can combine Brihuega with the following destinations: Sigüenza, Cifuentes, Guadalajara, Trillo or Torija
